CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The Convergence of Courage and Emancipatory Discourse exists within Black literature devoted to the sexual expression of persons of African descent. Courage is a product of the relativistic need and desire to research, create space, and tell our authentic stories. Emancipatory discourse is an outcome of authenticity and actualization. When we met two years ago in Havana, Cuba, we held discussions about the continuum and fluidity of Black sexuality that allowed participants to feel heard, be affirmed, healed and renewed. For this professional conference chapter of the ABSC, we are seeking research and clinical best practice proposals that demonstrate the convergence of courage and emancipatory discourse so that we are able to learn and be empowered to engage in advocacy and influential change.

The Association of Black Sexologists and Clinicians International Lecture Series involves critical discussion and feedback about black relationships and sexuality. Scholarly discussions may emerge from psychology, religion, education, sociology, history, philosophy, human services, communication. Proposals must be relevant and helpful to a mixed

conference audience comprised of sexual health scholars and clinicians. The lecture series will allow each participant to give an academic presentation and receive feedback from conference participants.

You (and your colleagues) will lead a 45-minute academic discussion about your research or clinical work at it relates to the conference theme, *“The Convergence of Courage and Emancipatory Discourse,”* followed by a facilitated 10-minute group discussion or questions on the work presented.

We welcome submission of individual and panel presentation proposals.

5. *At least one* Smart criterion-referenced learning objective.
